



Regency doors incorporate our patented glazing system, FlushGlaze™. Uniquely this system creates windows in the door which are flush with the surface without visible gaskets, prominent exterior beading or painted surfaces that can discolour. Regency doors are hung using three high security hinges to a dedicated PVC-U 70mm steel reinforced outer frame.

Through colours

Regency doors are made to order in Red, Black, Blue, Green and White and two woodgrain stains, Rosewood and Oak, all applied using the patented ColourFusion™ process. Regency doors have a genuine through colour layer that helps preserve the appearance of your door for year after year after year.

ColourFusion uses a unique method in which colour is added to the door surface during the moulding process so that the colour is actually fused into the material.

Regency's woodgrain stain finish has the natural appearance of an authentic timber

door using ColourFusion technology with the application of a grain enhancer to create a traditionally stained appearance. Our PVC-U woodgrain finish frames are created with a coating identical to that used for woodgrain colour finish PVC-U windows. The frame complements the door finish and, as is the way with natural timber, will be a similar but not an exact match.

Multipoint locking

Regency doors are supplied as standard with euro-profile cylinders (anti-pick and anti-drill to BS EN 1303) but have an option of cylinder-free multipoint locking that is a cost effective way of providing an anti-bump solution.



Amongst the very toughest materials are thermosetting resins. These become set after curing and the reapplication of heat will not reverse the chemical process that created them. Thus they remain strong, stable and durable whatever the temperature. They are what we use on the outside of Regency doors.

Inside your new door

A high quality engineered hardwood subframe is constructed to suit the individual door size. The material has been chosen for its combination of strength and dimensional stability. Strong dovetail joints lock everything tightly and squarely together.

At the heart of each door is a high density, CFC and HCFC free, closed cell core which has an insulation performance almost as good as cavity wall insulation.

A final touch

The addition of the EdgeGuard™ option further enhances the appearance of the door slab and adds extra protection against damage. This edge detail is fitted in powder coated white aluminium as standard with brown for woodgrain stain doors to add the finishing touch to your new Regency door.

With Regency doors there is a wide range of styles, designs and colours that allow you to choose from traditional and contemporary glass designs to provide the finishing touch that will help make your home the way you want it to be.

Toughened and fitted

As standard all doors are double glazed with 4mm toughened glass. For better thermal performance, we use low emission glass in all our ranges, except Elegance, so as to achieve even better insulation.

Coloured glass

For designs that incorporate coloured glass, you can choose the colour of the glass from Red, Green, Blue, Black and Clear. In this way you can choose colours that match or contrast with the colour of your door.

For some glazing designs you can choose matching glass for your toplights and sidelights. For side panels you can choose any glass design to match your door.

Side panels are window frames beside your door that are fitted with a panel with the same appearance and made to the same exacting standards as your Regency door. They provide an attractive alternative to traditional sidelight and toplight window frames. They are generally about the half the width of the door and always match the height of the door and its frame.

Glazed panels

Side panels can be fitted with glass just like your Regency door. They are glazed using FlushGlaze to get that smooth exterior appearance and you have the same choice of glass designs and colours as you do for your door. You can also mix and match your choices so that a solid front door can have a glazed side panel and vice versa. Side panel frames can also include toplight windows in most of our glass designs. You can see information on our sidelights and toplights on page 35.

Classic doors will not warp, twist, swell or rot and are easy to care for, maintenance generally means a simple wipe over with a damp cloth.

Because of their composite construction Classic doors meet modern performance expectations for heat and sound insulation, low maintenance, weather resistance, long life and burglar resistance. With a design life of 25 years or more, Classic doors have a 10 year guarantee.

At the heart of each door is a high density, CFC and HCFC free, closed cell core which has an insulation performance almost as good as cavity wall insulation. The core eliminates air gap weak spots and enhances structural rigidity.

Inside your door

A high quality engineered hardwood subframe is constructed to suit the individual door size. The material has been chosen for its combination of strength and dimensional stability. Strong dovetail joints lock the frames tightly and squarely together.

Authentic stable doors

The stable door features cylinder locking in both halves. The top half can be opened independently of the bottom half by releasing a slide bolt fixed to the inside face of the door. The lock cylinder in the top is key operated both sides and has a lever handle both sides that operates a latch and security hook. The lock cylinder in the bottom operates a deadbolt. With both parts unlocked and the slide bolt secured, the door will operate in the same way as an ordinary door. Both top and bottom are opened with the same key.

The final touch

To match the white finish of Classic doors we use white hinges. The addition of the white powder coated EdgeGuard™ further enhances the appearance of the door and adds extra protection.



EdgeGuard[™] provides additional protection to your door edge.

Cottage and Stable doors are available with a choice of glass

All Classic Cottage and Stable doors are supplied with double glazed toughened glass units in which the inside pane is always supplied in clear glass.

Glass choice

You can choose how obscure your glass is. After Clear, Minster™ is the least obscure, then Stippolyte™ with Cotswold™ the most difficult to see through.








The door frame is an important part of your doorset and we use strong steel reinforced PVC-U frames for all our doors so that the door and frame work together to prevent draughts and to stop rainwater getting in.





Reinforced construction

Homesafe door frames are made using 70mm PVC-U five chamber profile, fully reinforced with steel and triple sealed. All our frames are fully tested for ultraviolet resistance and colourfastness so that they will keep their appearance for many years. Frames provide good insulation and their rigidity ensures that draughts are eliminated.

Three frame colours

As standard all frames are finished in white. PVC-U woodgrain finish frames will complement the woodgrain door finishes and, as is the way with natural timber, will be similar but not an exact match. All frames are white on the inside.

Thresholds

We provide three threshold options and three cill options, so as to suit all requirements. Standard PVC-U welded thresholds are in white to match the door frame whilst low profile aluminium thresholds suitable for universal access are in an anodised silver or gold finish. Your surveyor will explain the options you need.



For wider entrances you can add sidelights and toplights that meet the needs of your home



Sidelights allow more light into your hallway as well as allowing the doorset to suit wider, non-standard openings.

Sidelights and toplights

These are window frames to the side and above your door. They can be glazed with most of the standard and decorative glass from our range and can also be finished with solid flush panels.

Heights and widths

Sidelights can be the full height of the door with either full height glass or a midrail; alternatively you can have a flag sidelight where the window comes about halfway down the height of the door.

Because they are made to measure, just like your door, you are not limited by set widths and so your sidelights and toplights will be the size you want them to be.

Glass designs

You can choose the glass design you want for your sidelights and toplights from our glass pages. Most of the designs are available and you can see which ones to choose from by using the icon .

Excellent security is essential so we use top quality hardware from proven manufacturers

There is a choice of colour finish for the door furniture for your new door. For a contemporary feel you can choose from black, white and chrome, whilst older style properties will be enhanced by black or polished gold.

Locking systems

Your new door will be fitted with multipoint locks as standard using hookbolts, centre latch and deadbolt to achieve the required level of security. These are now the first choice for residential doors as they provide better security and greater convenience than most other systems.

Lock operation

The split-spindle lock option offers enhanced security as your door cannot be opened using the handle on the outside without using a key. This means that you can simply pull your door closed as you leave, although it is better to lift the lever so as to engage the hookbolts, either way make sure you have your key with you.

Regency doors are fitted with the very latest multipoint locks that feature cylinder free operation with a traditional brass key.

Classic Cottage and Stable doors are fitted with anti-drill and anti-pick cylinder operated locks. Regency and Classic Cottage door multipoint locks all feature two bi-directional hooks, centre latch and deadbolt, whilst our Stable doors feature a single hook, latch and deadbolt multipoint lock to the top half and an additional security deadbolt for the bottom half (both operated by the same key).

All of our multipoint locks are Secured by Design licensed, which means that they have been approved by the Association of Chief Police Officers (ACPO). Kitemarked cylinder locks are also available.

Electronic locking

Electronic locking allows you to unlock your door as you approach, in the same way that remote car keys work.

Other Furniture

Regency doors use high quality robust bolt-through lever handles in anodised or powder-coated finishes.

A selection of letterplates, handle styles, security viewers, safety chains, numerals and knockers is available to provide the finishing touches to your new door.

Keeping your new door looking smart

Cleaning your door

Your door is made with either glassfibre reinforced polyester (Regency) or durable thermoplastic PVC-U (Classic) outer facings. Inner facings are PVC-U. These materials require no maintenance other than occasional cleaning.

Just a wipe over


All you need to do to clean the surface of your door is to wipe it over with a soft cloth, dampened in warm soapy water and then rinse and dry with another soft cloth. There is no need to use abrasive pads, abrasive cleaning creams, detergents, solvents or

bleach, in fact these might damage the finish of your door.

Door handles, knockers, viewers and letter plates should also be cleaned by wiping with a soft cloth dampened in warm soapy water and then rinsed and wiped dry with a soft cloth. There is no need to remove any furniture from the door or frame during cleaning.

Looking after the glass

You can clean the glass with a proprietary glass cleaner wiped clean with a soft dry cloth. It is best if spills on the surface of the door are rinsed and wiped off straightaway.
